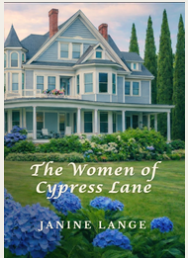

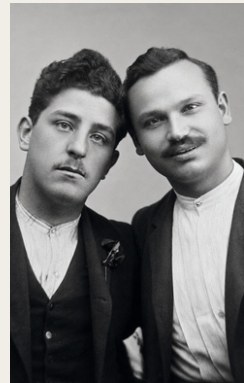
WHAT'S NEW AND EXCITING?
